Directions for use

Clax[®] 7XP1 is dosed into the first re-wash step of the wash process to remove rust marks and other stains that are reactive to an acid treatment. As a guide, dosage of 6-10g per kg of linen may be used. It is used on a low level and steam to around 60-70°C for approximately 6-12 minutes. It should be followed by at least two rinses then a wash using an alkaline detergent to neutralise the remaining acid. Rinse with potable water at the end of the laundering process.
