Directions for use

- 1. Dose via Diversey automatic dosing equipment.
- 2. Clax® Hypo 42A1 is typically dosed into the next step after the main wash.
- 3. Water level should be low and temperature should not exceed 60°C and optimum pH 10-10.8.

Light soil 3ml/Kg dry goods. Heavy soil 10ml/Kg dry goods. Rinse with potable water at the end of the laundering process. Please consult your Diversey representative for optimum performance.
